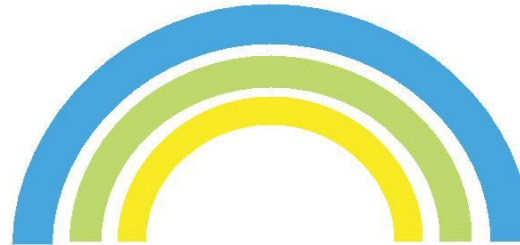

Junior Division students must live with a parent/guardian. There are a limited number of American host family homestays available to Junior Division students (ages 11 to 13) for One Weekend (optional, upon request).

Host Families provide basic room and board and involvement as a member of the family, not as a formal guest. Students enjoy the homestay experience by learning about American culture, taking part in daily life and having practice in conversational English.

Participants are responsible for: International travel expenses to and from Hawaii, travel documents (visa, passport, etc.), health/accident insurance (required), daily transportation to and from school, and housing. Students will also be expected to bring sufficient spending money to cover personal expenses, emergency expenditures and any debts incurred while in the U.S.
