International Admissions

St. Andrew's Schools offers two single gender schools on one campus conveniently located in downtown Honolulu.

The Priory, all-girls, Kindergarten through Grade 12

The Prep, all-boys, Kindergarten through Grade 8

International Student Tuition = \$26,000.00 Annual

***Tuition does not include textbooks (Grades 6-12 only), uniforms, laptop computer, or homestay.**

A student qualifies as an international student if *any one* of the following criteria is met:

- Needs an F-1 Student Visa
- Needs ESL support
- Needs home stay arrangements

ESL

English as a Second Language (ESL) classes are offered for students requiring ESL support as they attend classes with native English speakers who make up 95% of the student body. The ESL instructor works closely with classroom teachers to appropriately differentiate their instruction to match their English abilities. ESL students are offered additional one-on-one tutoring assistance/instruction in conversation, language structure, reading and writing.

Required Documents for Admission

- Passport – the photo/signature page of applicant's valid passport
- Transcript and any standardized testing results

- Official copies, with certified English translation
- Teacher Reference Reports
- Test Results for grades 6-12
 - TOEFL, the school code is 2559 OR
 - SSAT, the school code is 6274
- A Skype or Face Time interview with the student applicant

Required Documents for an F-1 Student Visa

Upon acceptance to the school, the family must submit:

- A signed Enrollment Contract (online) and Enrollment Deposit
- A color copy of the photo/signature page of the parents' valid passports
- Documentary evidence of means of financial support
- Proof of a responsible host family and legal guardian or that the student is living with her parents
- Immunization record

After the school receives all of the above items, a completed SEVIS Form I-20 will be sent to the family. Once the family receives the Form I-20 and pays the I-901 fee, they must schedule an interview appointment at the American Embassy.
