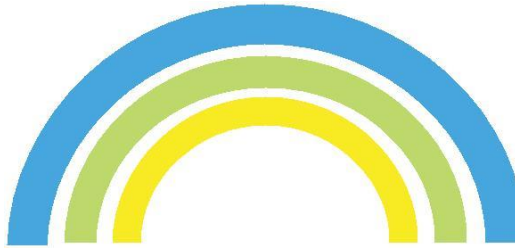

## HOMESTAY PROGRAM

There are a very limited number of American family homestays available to participants for one weekend. Host Families provide basic room and board and involvement as a member of the family, not as a formal guest. Participants enjoy the homestay experience as an opportunity to learn about American culture, take part in daily life and have practice in conversational English.

Participants are responsible for: International travel expenses to and from Hawaii, travel documents (visa, passport, etc.), health/accident insurance (required), and daily transportation to and from school. Students will also be expected to bring sufficient spending money to cover personal expenses, emergency expenditures and any debts incurred while in the U.S.
