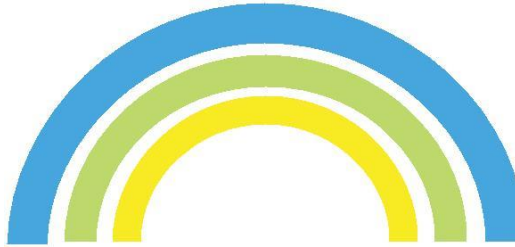

Students will also be expected to bring sufficient spending money to cover personal expenses, emergency expenditures and any debts incurred while in the U.S.
